**SUBJECT: Alert — Monthly Data Purge**  
**DATE: June 25, 2010**



**The following is an important *Alert* about the South Carolina Medicaid Web-based Claims Submission Tool (Web Tool).**

South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) runs a monthly data purge on the **first** day of each month. This process deletes all submitted claims, submitted batches, and un-submitted claims that are more than three months old from the South Carolina Medicaid Web-based Claims Submission Tool (Web Tool).



**The next data purge will run on the evening of July 1, 2010.**

**Claim Types Affected: CMS-1500, Dental, and UB-04**

- Un-submitted claims will be purged according to the date displayed in the **Date Last Updated** field on the Claims Results screen. The process on July 1, 2010, will purge all un-submitted claims last updated prior to March 31, 2010.
- View your submitted claims and submitted batches via the Reports option on the Main Menu, or via the History option on the Results screen. The process on July 1, 2010, will purge all claims submitted prior to March 31, 2010, (as indicated in the Date Submitted field on the Submitted Batches screen).
- Remember – if you want to keep copies of affected claims for your records, you will need to print copies prior to the July 1, 2010, data purge.
